Trevor & Norma Douglas, World Team, Philippines

Douglases are on a 9-months-in-Canada-3-months-in-the-Philippines schedule. In Canada, they mentor other missionaries by zoom. Norma does Child Safeguarding as well as archiving for World Team USA. Trevor translates books into the Ifugao language. He recently completed a 5-book series on Biblical Balance and presently has only two letters left to translate in a Bible Dictionary (M and N). In the Philippines, they have a



yearly circuit doing both member and watchcare. Once back in Ifugao, they publish their translated books, teach in the tribal Bible School, audit the school's finances, speak at various trainings addressing current problems, and consult with the board of directors of their 150 tribal churches.
