Missionary of the Week Trevor and Norma Douglas World Team/Philippines

The mountainous Province of Ifugao (headhunters into the 20th century) was pioneered by Wycliffe. After the NT was translated (1972), Trevor was sent in to teach, and He began a Bible school. He helped translate the OT and translated or edited 13 books. He also wrote 35 books in the Ifugao language, the last two of which are presently being printed. 150 churches are the fruit of the now indigenous Bible school. The Douglas's are currently on their annual visit to Ifugao to encourage, coach, and teach the people. Pray for funds to renovate their house, which is storm-damaged and infested by termites. Built on Bible school land, they wish to leave it to them in usable condition.

General Fund income for February was almost \$6,700 below budget. That is a concern, but it was an 11.72% increase over February of 2025. Since expenses were \$4,500 under budget, our General Fund's deficit for the month was only \$2,859, which is almost identical to our January deficit. Our year-to-date income for the General Fund is almost \$23,400 under budget, but our expenses are also under budget. While our year-to-date deficit of \$14,544 is higher than we anticipated, we still maintain our grade as an "A." From our Prairie College Bursary Fund (not shown here) the Finance Committee was able to give bursaries of \$1,000 each to four college students who are active in our church ministries. Thank you to each donor who supports the Lord's work here.
