**“Premillennialism & The Tab: A Simple Apologetic on
Why The Tab Takes the Premillennial Position”**

Things to think about:

- Trevor said The Tab got its premillennial position on the Second Coming of Christ from PBI’s doctrinal statement, but then adjusted it slightly. Are you glad, or sad, The Tab is premillennial? Why?
- The basis for coming to the premillennial position is the historical-grammatical-literal hermeneutic of Scripture. Do you accept this hermeneutic as the best system of interpretation to do the job of “rightly dividing the Word of Truth?”
- Trevor talked about the danger of The Slippery Slope when using the allegorizing, spiritualizing hermeneutic. Is this a realistic danger? How could the slippery slope actually happen?
- Replacement Theology, which is moving from the East Coast out here to the West, teaches that the church inherits all the prophetic promises given to Israel since she rejected her Messiah. Israel, therefore, is a nothing-nation today, and we Christians shouldn’t treat it any differently from any other nation. Do you accept this teaching? If you do, what then do you do with Rom. 11:11-32 which teaches that Israel some day will be re-grafted into God’s tree?
- What is a personal application you can make to your own life from the sermon on premillennialism?
